

Dual Enrollment at Link Learning:

What You Need to Know

Dual enrollment is open to *everyone** at Link - start earning college credit today!

Here are some guidelines for the dual enrollment process:

Cost

Link Learning will cover up to **\$762.50** in tuition, fees, and book costs. If the course costs more, you may still register for it, but note that you will be responsible for covering the difference.

Course Details

Courses cannot be content that you could take at Link - this is a chance to learn something new and cool, or get started on your degree!

Grades

You must get a **70% or better** in your college course to qualify for tuition coverage. If you end the course with a D or lower, you will be expected to reimburse your tuition cost to Link Learning.

Student Schedule

Dual enrollment courses count as **two** of your classes for the 6-class semester. **CTE dual enrollment counts as 3 classes.**

*Students must be enrolled at Link and have at least one parent who is a Michigan resident. 5th and 6th year students may not participate if they've already exceeded the maximum of 10 dual enrollment courses.

The Dual Enrollment Process:

1. Meeting

Students (and parents if the student is a minor) must meet with their mentor, center director, and the dual enrollment coordinator at Link Learning.

2. Application

Students must apply at their chosen institution. Once accepted, send the acceptance email to the dual enrollment coordinator.

4. Submit Packet and Start Classes

Make sure all fields are filled in and send the packet to the dual enrollment coordinator. Then, sit back and get ready for a great semester!

3. Registration

Students will then register for the class they want to take. Make sure to add the course name and number to the appropriate spots on the dual enrollment packet.

Tips for Dual Enrollment:

- Set a schedule for getting your work done - remember, you'll have homework for your college class AND your 25% weekly progress to get done
- Note if your class is online or in-person. Make sure you have consistent transportation if your class is in-person, Link does not provide any!
- Keep your email notifications on - you don't want to miss a message from your professor!
- Remember to order your transcripts once your final grade has been submitted - we need it to give you your dual credit
